The Chairman, Sri Nandha Educational Trust, Erode has applied for establishment of a new Medical College at Perundurai Main Road, Pitchandampalayam Post, Erode District. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Tamil Nadu have decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a new Medical College in the name and style as "NANDHA MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL" Erode with an annual intake of 150 seats subject to the following conditions and also to fulfil the other associated conditions for approval by National Medical Commission is solely vested with the applicant:-

- a) Before admitting the students the Trust should complete all the construction work, if any, under progress and building completion certificate for these buildings should be obtained. The same have to be furnished before the National Medical Commission.
- b) Building stability certificate of the hospital building should be obtained from the appropriate authority.
- c) Further bank guarantees specified by National Medical Commission for the establishment of teaching hospital to be handed over to the National Medical Commission, New Delhi.
- d) For the buildings, the approval already obtained from the local body i.e President, Pitchandampalayam Post, Erode District vide மு.மு. 41/2009-2010, dated 24.06.2009 shall be got approved / concurred by the DTCP.
- e) The Trust should also produce mandatory certificates (viz., AERB approval, CSSD, Environmental Impact Assessment Certificate, Pollution Control Board Certificate, PCPNDT Act Certificate and Blood Bank Certificate) before the National Medical Commission's inspection without-fail.

- f) The Trust should abide National Medical Commission's norms updated from time to time without any lapse.
- g) The Trust ensures the undertaking given by them to rectify the deficiencies pointed out by the Government / Inspection Officers before the National Medical Commission's inspection.
- h) The Trust should ensure the availability of 100% faculties, infrastructures, equipment, clinical and non clinical materials as per the National Medical Commission's norms, without-fail.
- i) The Trust should obtain the approval of National Medical Commission.

It is certified that:-

- a. The applicant owns and manages a 330 bedded functional Hospital which was established in the campus of the proposed location.
- b. It is desirable and feasible to establish a Medical College in the Public interest.
- c. Establishment of a Medical College at Perundurai Main Road, Pitchandampalayam Post, Erode by "NANDHA MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL" is feasible.
- d. Adequate Clinical Material as per the National Medical Commission norms is available.


It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Medical College as per the National Medical Commission norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the National Medical Commission, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of students already admitted in the College with the permission of the National Medical Commission.

- e. The Trust own and possesses 25.58 acres of land in comprising in S.No. 10/1, 2, 3, 5 to 15, 9/6, 7, 8, 9, 252/1A, 2A, 7B, 258/4, 260/1, 26, 28, 41/6, 253/3C, 5A, 6, 7 10, 26, 28, 235/3, 5, 6, 7 Puthur puthupalayam Village, Veppampalayam Village, Erode Taluk and District of SRI NANDHA EDUCATIONAL TRUST, Erode on which non-agricultural use of land is permitted and a Medical College and Hospital can be established on it.
- f. The building plan of the Hospital and Medical College has been approved by the authority, namely, the President, Pitchandam Palayam, Erode.

- g. The Hospital and Medical College has been granted Land Use Certificate / Fit to Run Certificate by the Competent authority, namely, Thasildar Erode designated by the Government for such purpose vide. K.Dis. No.481/2021/A2 dated 3.02.2021.

The Essentiality Certificate shall be valid for 3 years from the date of issue.
